## Disability Support Services

---

Welcome to all students who will be studying at Waiariki Institute of Technology.

Waiariki is committed to providing education that is accessible to all students by providing support, assistance and advice in a private and confidential manner to those who may require additional help. Please contact the Disability Administrator as early as possible in order for us to assess any appropriate support you may need to help you succeed in your studies.

### Eligibility

Please reply with "YES" on your Waiariki Application and Enrolment Form if you have a disability or impairment that may affect your learning. This may be temporary or long term and include medical, sensory (hearing/vision), physical, mental health or learning.

The Disability Administrator will contact you to discuss the impact of your disability, your support needs while on campus and the availability of additional disability support staff on campus.



## Equipment

Assistive technology is available for you to borrow should you require. This includes dictaphones, amplifiers, software, wheelchairs, crutches, hearing loops and ergonomic aids.

## Special Arrangements

If you have an impairment or disability that will significantly impact on your academic performance in examinations, you can apply for special arrangements to be made for exams and tests.

Types of special arrangements that may be provided include:

- Extra time
- Reader/Writer
- Use of computer
- Separate room

## Parking

There are numerous mobility car parks on campus and the legitimate use of these parks is monitored. A printed map showing the location of the mobility car parks is available from the Health Centre. Waiariki mobility cards are also available from the Health Centre.



## Campus Access

Most Waiariki buildings are wheelchair accessible by ramp and have an accessible toilet within close proximity. As soon as you know the location of your course please contact the Disability Administrator for more information and maps.

## Scholarships and Grants
