GOAL 10

Increase the productive capability of the region

Actions

- Offer qualifications that reflect the significant employment and added value sectors in the region.
- Develop qualifications at levels 5-7 that align with regional needs.
- Respond to new industry developments, trends and opportunities.
- Proactively source or develop value added solutions to satisfy technical and vocational needs.
- Ensure all level 1-3 qualifications have a pathway to higher learning and increase the number of level five to seven qualifications underpinned by applied research.

GOAL 11

Increase the level of provision to satisfy core and niche demand for skills and knowledge across the four core market segments.

Actions

- Engage in collaborative provision, in communities, iwi and industries across the region and nationally.
- Grow Waiariki's four core business areas – school leavers, second chance full time learners, part time learners and international students.
- Increase income achieved through international education by choosing focused partnerships with quality organisations in a balanced range of countries that allow student articulation, staff and student exchanges.
- Encourage and maximise leverage of shared investment in educational services and resources.
- Ensure content of TVET qualifications captures relevant technologies from across the world placing New Zealand at the leading edge of technology innovation and application.

GOAL 12

Produce a surplus for reinvestment by operating in a financially prudent, viable and sustainable manner.

Actions:

- Gain efficiencies in provision through focus on key drivers
- Rationalise qualifications and courses through portfolio review and alignment.
- Expand Waiariki's financial base of non-government funding income sources.
- Prioritise applications for targeted public and industry funding opportunities.
- Implement a Capital Asset Management System (CAM), Human Resource Information System (HRIS), Financial Investment Based Management system (FIBS) and Student Management System (SMS) as per ITP benchmarking projects.

- Whakautua ki ngā whakawhānaketanga mahinga, ngā tikanga, me ngā mea angitū.
- Kākamangia te taketake, whakawhānake rānei, i ngā whakamāramatanga wāriu tāpiri atu, kia mākona ai ngā hiahia toi me ngā hiahia mahi.
- Whakaōatingia ngā tohu taumata tuatahi ki te tuatoru katoa, e rite ai ki tētahi ara, ki ngā ako piki ake, me te nui hāere i te nāmā o ngā tohu taumata rima ki te whitu, e tautoko ai i ngā rangahau a mahi.

TOHENGATEKAU MA TAHI

Whakarāhinga te taumata o ngā ratonga, kia mākona ai te tono matū me te tono kōkoru ma ngā pūkenga, me te mōhiotanga whakawhiti atu i ngā wāhanga hokona matū e whā.

Ngā Mahi:

- Whakawhānake i roto i te ratonga whakahoahoa, i ngā hāpori, i te Iwi, me ngā mahinga whakawhiti atu i te rohe, a, huri noa i te motu.
- Whakatupungia ngā wā kaupākihi matū e whā – Ngā hunga whakarērea kura tuarua, ngā akonga wā kiki, ngā akonga wā wāhanga, me ngā akonga a taiāo
- Whakarāhinga ngā moni hua ka tāea ma te mātauranga a taiāo, ma te whiwhi o ngā tūhonotanga, e hāngai ana ki ngā rōpū whakahāere painga, i tētahi pae whakarite o ngā whenua o te āo, e tāea ai te māhakitanga o ngā akonga, me te whakawhiti atu o ngā kaimahi me ngā akonga.
- Whakaakiakia me te whakanui ake i te mana o te tūari moni whakangāo, i ngā ritenga mātauranga me ngā rauemi.
- Whakaōatingia te ngako o ngā tohu mātauranga toi, mātauranga mahi me te whakangūngūtanga (TVET), e hāo ana i ngā mahi toi e pā ana, whakawhiti atu i te āo, e nohōia ana a Aotearoa i te mata arataki o ngā wairuatanga auaha toi me te māmahinga.

TOHENGATEKAU MA RUA

Whakaāturia he tūwhene moni whakangāo anō e whakahāere ana i te ritenga tūpato moni hua, i te ritenga whaihua, me te ritenga tokona.

Ngā Mahi

- Whiwhia ngā māia i roto i ngā ratonga ma ngā kaitaraiwa matua e hāngai ana.
- Whakapūtakengia ngā tohu me ngā kōhi ma te tirohanga hou a tari, me te whakahāngaitanga.
- Whakawhānuitia te papa tahu a Waiariki i ngā mātauranga moni hua, kōhi moni kore kāwanatanga
- Whakatuatahitia ngā tono mo ngā hūanga kōhi moni iwi whānui pirona, me ngā hūanga kōhi moni mahinga.
- Whakatīnanatia he pūnaha whakahāere rawa moni punga, he pūnaha rongo aro tāngata, he pūnaha whakahāere papa moni whakangāo tahu, me te pūnaha whakahāere akonga, e hāngai tonu ana ki ngā kaupapa e whakatauritia ana, e ngā whare takiūra me ngā kuratini o Aotearoa.
