Ensure that Waiariki operates within a bicultural framework that acknowledge the Treaty of Waitangi principles of partnership, participation and protection; that Waiariki actively demonstrates leadership and facilitation; and takes up engagement opportunities to partnership and collaborate.

GOAL 1

Ensure that Waiariki operates within a unique bicultural framework and acknowledges the Treaty of Waitangi through active demonstration of the principles of partnership, participation and protection.

Actions

- Reinforce Waiariki's support of the principles of partnership, protection and participation through active demonstration in activities.
- Provide learning experiences which enable graduates to be cross-culturally sensitive, inter-culturally competent and internationally knowledgeable.
- Prioritise exploring more diverse cultural curricula, inclusive methods of teaching, and innovative access and retention strategies.
- Provide niche curricula in cultural heritage with a strong kaupapa that reflect and customise provision to the unique Waiariki regional communities.
- Provide a defined welcoming and ongoing bicultural experience for all students.
- Align ethnic staff profile through application of Equal Employment Opportunities principles and bicultural kaupapa.

GOAL 2

Manage external engagement and lead the Regional Facilitation process

Actions

- Continue effective regional engagement that leads to enhanced shared understanding of needs and priorities and adoption of the annual Regional Statement by the region's stakeholders
- Assume a leading role in the establishment of regional and national niche business, social and economic clusters;
- Develop and strengthen stakeholder relationships and partnership agreements to become the preferred provider of Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) in the region.
- Support and participate in the strategic planning processes of regional and Iwi authorities, Hapu and community organisations.

GOAL 3

Strengthen existing opportunities and widen scope for sustainable growth through collaboration and partnerships with key stakeholders.

Actions:

- Develop collaborative partnerships with Iwi to increase engagement of Māori.
- Increase the number and quality of international students both onshore and offshore.
- Implement processes to identify key risks and uncertainty as part of the critical success factor evaluation for MOU, agreements and articulations.
- Manage opportunity and risk through developing a coordinated mix of countries, economies, currencies, and courses.

TOHENGATUATAHI

Whakaōatingia a Waiariki ki roto i te ahurei anga tikanga ā rua, e manakohia ana ki Te Tiriti o Waitangi mā ngā mahi kakama i ngā mātāpono, whakahoahoa, mahitahi me te tiākitanga.

Ngā Mahi:

- Whakapakari te tautokona a Waiariki i ngā mātāpono o Te Tiriti o Waitangi mā te pau kaha o ngā mahi.
- Whakararongia ngā mānanga ako ka tāea e ngā taura te tūtohu whakawhiti tikanga, te māia tikanga whiria, me te mātau a tāiāo.
- Whakatuatahitia te toro atu i ngā marautanga tikanga maha, ngā whakaako tikanga urunga, me te pūtanga rerekētanga, me ngā whakatakoto kaupapa pūpuritanga.
- Whakararongia ngā marautanga kōkoro i te tāonga pūmau ki tētahi kaupapa e ngākaunuitia ana ki ngā hāpori a takiwa i te rohe o te Waiariki.
- Whakararongia he pōhiri whakamāramatanga me te mānanga whakamua tikanga a rua, mā ngā akonga katoa
- Whakahāngaitia ngā hūanga kaimahi māwaka mā te tono mātāpono angitū mahi ōrite me te kaupapa tikanga a rua.

TOHENGATUARUA

Whakahāerengia te whakaanga a waho, me te arataki i te mahi tokona a rohe.

Ngā Mahi:

- Hāere tonu te whakaanga tōtika a rohe, kia arataki ai te whakamōhio tūhono whakarei i ngā mea tuatahi me ngā hiahiatanga, me te whakapūmautanga i te ripoata a rohe e ngā hunga whakangāo a rohe.
- Tangohia he whakatū arataki i te whakapūmautanga o ngā kāhui whakahāerenga moni, pāpori, kaipākihi kōkoro, a rohe, a motu anō hoki.
- Whakawhānākengia me te whakakahangia i ngā whanaungatanga hunga whakangāo, me ngā whakaāetanga whakahoahoa, kua eke ki te pai ake o ngā kaiwhakariterite i te mātauranga toi, mātauranga mahi, me te whakangūngūtanga (TVET) i te rohe.
- Tautokongia, me te whai wāhi i ngā mahi kōpū whakatakoto kaupapa o ngā rōpū whakamana a Iwi, a rohe anō hoki, me ngā rōpū whakahāere a hapu, a hāpori anō hoki.

Ngā Mahi

- Whakawhānākengia ngā whakahoahoa mahitahi ki te Iwi, kia piki ake ai te whakaanga i te Iwi Māori.
- Whakararongia te nāmā me te painga o ngā akonga a tāiāo, a motu, a tāwahi anō hoki.
- Whakatūnātia ngā mahi māhio ai ngā tino raru, me te rangirua, hei wāhanga o te whakamātau take taumaha angitū, mā ngā whakaātūranga whakamōhioatanga (MOU), ngā whakaāetanga me ngā wahapūtanga.
- Whakahāerengia te hūanga me te raru i roto i te whakawhānake i te hanumi tuitui o ngā whenua, o ngā whakahāerenga moni, o ngā moni, me ngā kōhi.
